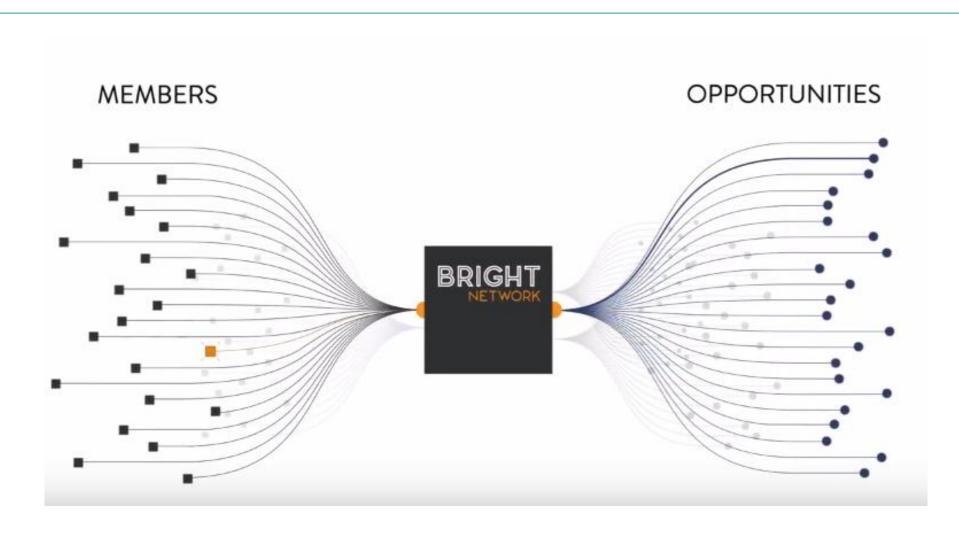

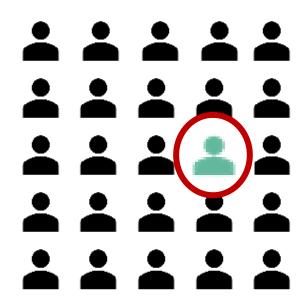

54% of our LGBT members have the same opinion

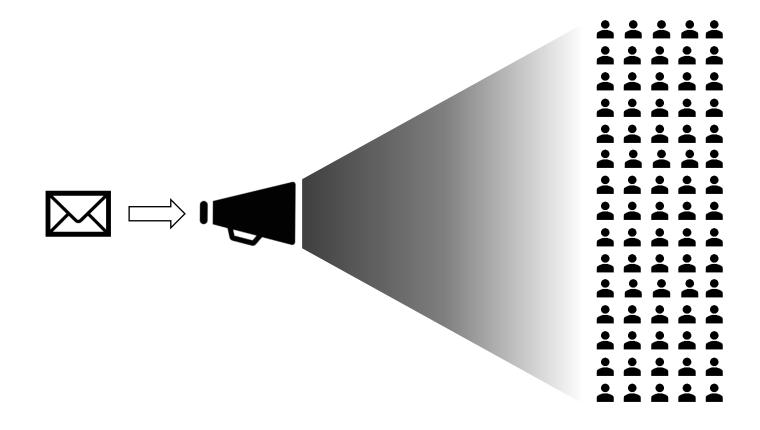
